#### Meeting Called to Order

Joe Casciano, Chairman of MARRC, called the meeting to order at 10:00 am.

# **Opening Remarks**

In his opening remarks, the Chairman thanked the province's Collectors and Processors who serve the many generators in the Province along with the EcoCentres and licensed collection facilities being operated by municipalities and other organizations to serve Manitoba, our Partners, Members, Directors and Staff. # Constitution of the Meeting

Joe Casciano, Chairman of MARRC, read the roll call of Registered attendees (listed below) and asked for any attendees who were not called to introduce themselves.

#### Consent for the Participation

Richard Waller, Imperial Oil motioned to consent for the participation and vote of those MARRC members who are attending the meeting by ZOOM. Emmy Encheta, Bluewave Energy seconded. The motion carried.

Lutz Ehrentraut, Secretary-Treasurer of MARRC, confirmed that a quorum of the 209 Members were represented comprised of 7 Members in attendance in person and by ZOOM and 9 Members by proxy for a total of 16.

## Adoption of Agenda

Paul Linchuang, Modern Sales motioned that the Agenda be adopted as circulated. Emmy Ancheta, Bluewave Energy, seconded the motion. The motion carried.

## Adoption of Minutes of previous Annual General Meeting

Paul Linchuang, Moderns Sales, motioned that the Minutes of the 26th Annual General Meeting of MARRC of April 26, 2023, be adopted as presented. Richard Waller, Imperial Oil, seconded. The motion carried.

#### Adoption of 2023 Audited Financial Statements

Emmy Ancheta, Bluewave Energy, motioned that the Audited Financial Statements for 2023 be received as presented, and Paul Linchuang, Modern Sales, seconded the motion. The motion carried.

#### Proposed Resolution to Increase the Environmental Handling Charges (EHCs) on Oil Filters & Antifreeze

Chris Herle, Federated Co-Operatives Ltd., motioned and Emmy Ancheta, Bluewave Energy, seconded the Motion that on January 1, 2025, the following increases in EHC would take effect:

- Oil filters 8" or less from \$0.50 to \$0.55
- Oil filters 8" or greater from \$1.00 to \$1.25
- Antifreeze concentrate & premix from \$0.08 per litre to \$0.16 per litre

The motion carried.

# **Appointment Auditors for 2024**

Emmy Ancheta, Bluewave Energy, motioned that PricewaterhouseCoopers, chartered accountants, be appointed auditors of the corporation for the fiscal year to end on December 31, 2024. Chris Herle, Federated Co-Operatives Ltd, seconded the motion. The motion carried. Mageswaran Palany, Wakefield Canada Inc., inquired if price comparisons were obtained on any other auditing company. Aaron advised there hadn't been recently. Jerry Coben, SARRC Chairman, noted that some time ago, the UOMAs did in fact compare auditing companies. Aaron advised that prices from other auditing companies would be obtained for 2025.

#### Election of Board of Directors

The Chairman explained that the terms of three of MARRC's five Directors would expire as of today's meeting. Those Directors were:
